Hello Southwest Providers,

During these most challenging times, we want to extend our gratitude to you for your continuing service to children and families. We want to assure you that Southwest Human Development remains committed to supporting you in this most critical service you provide to families that are on the front lines protecting the health and safety of our communities and providing critical healthcare services.

As you most likely have heard on the news Texas has implemented "Stay At Home" (also called "Shelter-In-Place) orders. For more information visit <u>Texas.gov</u> | <u>Governor Abbott Issues Executive Order</u>

These "Stay-At-Home" orders have implications for childcare, including childcare homes. Childcare operations are permitted to operate under these "Stay-At-Home" orders; however, each local government's orders have specific and unique characteristics that define what childcare operations can operate and under what conditions. Generally speaking, these orders will allow childcare to operate on a limited basis; services are generally limited to families whose parents work in an "essential" service (such as healthcare, public safety, grocery stores, etc.). This means you may be prohibited from serving some or all of your families. In addition, some of the orders limit group size below licensed capacity. Lastly, the duration of these orders may vary by jurisdiction. This is why It is essential that you read the details of the orders for your city or county.

Southwest Human Development is continuing its operations and is available to assist you with your questions and meal reimbursement claim. The February

claim has been processed; checks were mailed on March 23 and direct deposit payments hit on March 25, We will process March claims in April and are presuming for now that March claims will be paid on time at the end of April. The office will remain "open" during the "Stay-At-Home" Order due to the nature of work providing essential services for childcare. Many of you have let us know you have temporarily closed your childcare home. Please be sure to let us know you are closed or will be closing and when you anticipate re-opening (if you haven't already informed us). Operations that have indicated they have temporarily closed due to COVID-19 related issues are not displayed being displayed on the licensing website. However, they are not permanently closed in the system. If you are closed and want to re-open and this is allowed by your local health officials and permissible under your local city or county emergency orders; You can contact your local licensing representative regarding their status. In addition, if you wish to re-open to serve families of essential workers you may sign up through the Frontline Child Care website. Information for this website can be found on here

Again, we are grateful at Southwest Human Development for the services you provide to children and families. Childcare is an essential service during normal circumstances, and has become even more essential for the limited number of families that must continue being out in the community protecting all our health and safety.
